A 'Notice to Fence' is a legal document that can be

Notice should be sent by registered post to neighbour. Tenants must forward the notice to their landlord within 14 days by registered post or they may become liable for the cost. If within one month after the service of the notice to the person served does not agree then the matter maybe referred to the Magistrate's Court for an order to fence stating the type and cost to be shared.
